
## Using The AKC Reunite ProScan 700 Multi-System Scanner

- 1. Remove the plastic wrapping and insert batteries prior to use.
- 2. Press and release the yellow button to turn the scanner on. The scanner will light up and indicate the number of the last microchip read, if applicable.
- 3. Please note: press & hold the Yellow button down continuously while scanning the pet. (This applies to steps 4 through 7.)
- 4. Hold the ring of the scanner at a 30° angle against the pet with the right or left edge touching the pet. The right and left edges of the ring are the optimal read areas for the scanner.
- 5. Scan the area between the shoulder blades for optimal microchip detection.
- 6. Scan slowly, giving the scanner time to detect the microchip. If no microchip is detected between the shoulder blades, scan a broader area, including the front legs down to the elbows and the neck.



- 7. When a microchip is detected, the scanner will give a high-pitched beep and the screen will display the type of microchip along with the unique microchip number.
- 8. The scanner will automatically turn itself off after approximately 30 seconds of inactivity.
- For future reference: if the scanner is working slowly, replace the four AA batteries.
- 10. Also included in the box is a USB cable for future upgrades to the scanner.
